

San Carlos Charter Residence Verification, Age Requirements for Kindergarteners, and Immunization Requirements

Residence Verification

The following must be provided as proof of residency:

- 1) Current original utility bills from two different sources.
- 2) You must also present one of the following:
 - Homeowners:** Sales contract, grant deed, or current tax bill.
 - Renters:** Rental agreement and name, address, and phone number of landlord/manager.

OR if unable to produce 1 or 2 above, you must provide a deed, tax bill or rental agreement and utility bills of person with whom you are living, along with a notarized Affidavit of Residency Form (may be obtained from school).

Caregiver's Affidavit (if learner is living with a relative other than parent)

You must provide an affidavit stating the learner is living with a relative other than the parent. The caregiver must also prove residency as stated above.

Joint Custody

You must provide copy of court-ordered joint physical custody order and must also prove residency as noted above.

Age Requirement For Incoming Kindergarteners

State law requires that to be eligible for Kindergarten in September 2020, a child must be five (5) years of age on or before September 1, 2020. You must present a Birth Certificate or Baptismal Certificate duly attested (original), or a passport, at the time of acceptance.

Immunization Requirements

You must provide an immunization record showing your child has received all of the required immunizations to date. Medical exemptions will be validated at the time of acceptance according to state law. If you are an immigrant and have an 1-94 Form, please have it available at the time of acceptance. ***Please see the attached for information regarding California's current immunization schedule.***

Health Examination

California law requires that children have a health examination completed not more than eighteen (18) months prior to entry into the first grade or within ninety (90) days thereafter. However, we strongly encourage that the exam be completed before starting Kindergarten. The school will provide the appropriate form (PM 171A) on request. School personnel will provide details about completing a waiver or exemption, for deeply held personal beliefs that would cause you to not want your child examined.

THE REGISTRATION PROCESS IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.
